

## **DR. STYA PAUL YOUNG EDUCATIONIST AWARD**

Apeejay Stya Education Research Foundation (ASERF), supported by Apeejay Stya Group, a leading Industrial and Investment House of India, has instituted 'Dr Stya Paul Young Educationist Award' for honouring Young Educationists who have demonstrated their potential by making an impact on Indian education.

**Eligibility:** A Citizen of India below the age of 45 years, who has published books, research papers in Indian or international journals on any aspect of Indian education such as Early Childhood education, elementary education, teacher education, higher education, technical and professional education is eligible for consideration for the award. The published work should be such as is indicative of the author's original contribution to the advancement of educational thought or improvement in educational practices in the Indian context. *The Award comprise a cash amount of Rs. 50,000/-, a robe of honour and citation.*

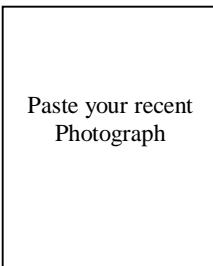
ASERF invites application from the eligible scholars for the Award for the year 2006. The prescribed format along with the terms and conditions are given in the following pages.

### **Number of Awards**

The scheme envisages Two awards every year which comprise a cash amount of Rs. 50,000/-, a robe of honour and a citation.

### **Selection of the Award**

- ASERF invites entries through advertisements in newspapers from individual scholars. The scholars are requested to submit brief resume of their contribution along with copies of their publications.
- The scholars shall submit three copies of each publication published during the preceding five years. The publications may include :
  - i. Original books on any aspect of education, and
  - ii. Research papers published in Indian or International professional journals
- The scholars may also submit manuscripts of papers accepted for publication.
- The books edited or translated or co-authored by the scholar shall not be considered in the category of books. However the chapters contributed by the scholar may be considered in the category of papers.
- ASERF gives awards on the recommendations of a committee of experts which evaluates the publications submitted by the individuals against the criteria of significance, relevance, originality, and potential for making impact on the system.
- The decision of the Foundation shall be final.

### **Terms and Conditions**

- The scholar should be below 45 years of age on the last day of the year for which the award is announced.
- Text books, help books or books covering syllabi of different universities for various examinations shall not be considered.
- Preceding five years implies five years before the last day of the award year. For example, for the award year 2009, publications from the year 2005 to 2009 shall be considered.
- The recipient of award in a year shall not be considered again for it in the next five years.
- The publications submitted under the scheme shall remain with the Foundation.
- The scholar should give names of two referees who have observed his/her work from close quarters and, therefore, are in a position to provide objective assessment.
- Two awards will be given each year, one for school/teacher education and other for Higher/Professional/Technical education
